This committee met on 10 to 11th November, 2022 and has been informed vide self-contained note that **77 applications** have been received for compassionate appointment. Before scrutiny of these applications, the Committee has gone through the below mentioned instructions regarding Compassionate appointment. (Reviewed till June 2022, which has been taken cut off date)

(i)The DOPT vide O.M. No. 14014/02/2012-Estt. (D) dated 16.01.2013 had issued the consolidated instructions on compassionate appointment under the Central Government. As per Para-1 of said O.M., **the object of the scheme is to grant appointment on compassionate grounds to a dependent family member of a Government servant dying in harness or who is retired on medical grounds, thereby leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood, to relieve the family of the Government servant concerned from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency.** As per Note-I of Para-2of O.M. ibid, **'dependent family member' means: (a) spouse, or (b) son (including adopted son), or (c) daughter (including adopted daughter), or (d)brother or sister in the case of unmarried Government servant,** who was wholly dependent on the
